Imagine trying to sing in your church choir\*, but your bookmarks\* keep falling out of your songbook\*! That was the problem Art Fry, a scientist at the 3M company, faced in the 1970s. He needed a bookmark that would stick lightly to the paper but wouldn't tear it when pulled off. Earlier, another scientist at 3M, Dr. Spencer Silver, had invented a special glue. It was an adhesive\* that was "low-tack," meaning it could stick things together weakly and be removed easily without leaving a mark. Unfortunately, no one at the company could figure out what to use this strange glue for. When Fry heard about Silver's low-tack glue, he had a flash of genius! He realized the weak glue was perfect for his bookmark problem. He put the glue on the back of small pieces of paper. These little notes stuck to pages, could be pulled off easily, and could even be stuck somewhere else again. The company was hesitant\* at first, but after a successful test launch, the "Press 'n Peel" notes became the famous Post-it Note in 1980. This simple idea shows how two separate inventions—a problem (Fry's bookmarks) and a solution (Silver's glue)—came together to create one of the most useful products in the world
