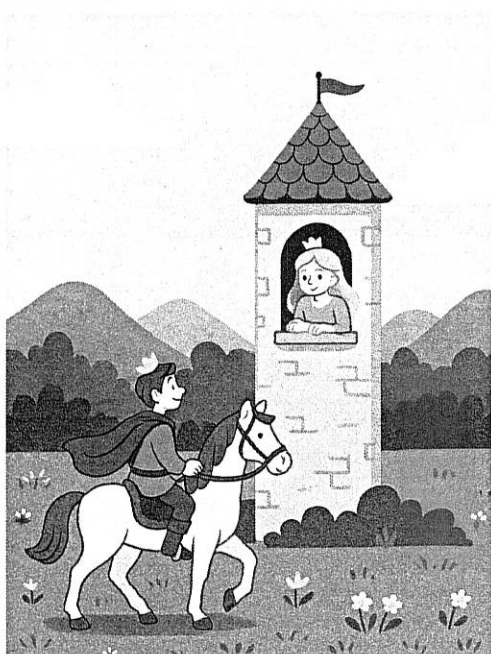

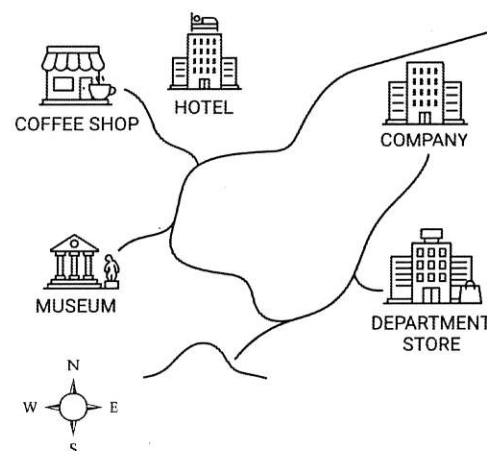

Do you like doing word search puzzles? Scientists say that doing them often can help improve your memory and make it easier to learn new words. These puzzles train your brain to spot letter patterns that many English words __31__.

The first English word search puzzle was created in 1968 by an American for a local publication. The creator hid the names of towns inside a box of letters. Today, there are many different __32__ of word search puzzles. Some have words that curve rather than run straight. Others hide secret messages that appear only after all the words are found. In some, you don't even get a word list—you have to __33__ the hidden words yourself!

You might have seen such a scene—someone is talking but their lips hardly move. This clever skill is called ventriloquism. Skilled ventriloquists keep their mouths almost closed and move their tongues very carefully. These and other vocal actions allow them to make voices that seem __36__ from thin air.
