The word “meme” first appeared in Richard Dawkins’s book *The Selfish Gene* in 1976. He used it to 2 mean a small piece of 3 cultural information.

It can 4 copy and spread like a 5 gene. As the internet grew, memes became a way for people to share ideas online.

Memes usually show a picture with simple words. People can use their 6 own ideas to make new memes. They show people’s 7 feelings, daily lives, or social issues. So, many people feel the same way when they see these memes.

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(二) Can’t Get a Song Out of Your Head? It’s an Earworm!

Earworms happen to almost everyone. They are like 1 mosquito 2 bites. They 3 itch, so you want to 4 scratch them. Earworms make you “scratch” the itch by playing the song in your head. However, this keeps the earworm going!

5 Hearing a tune or word can make an earworm happen. For example, the word “birthday” might make you remember the birthday song. Strong emotions can also make you remember songs from your past.

Some 6 businesses make good use of earworms. They write catchy tunes to make people remember their items. TV 7 advertisement songs, pop songs, and children’s songs are all common examples of earworms.
