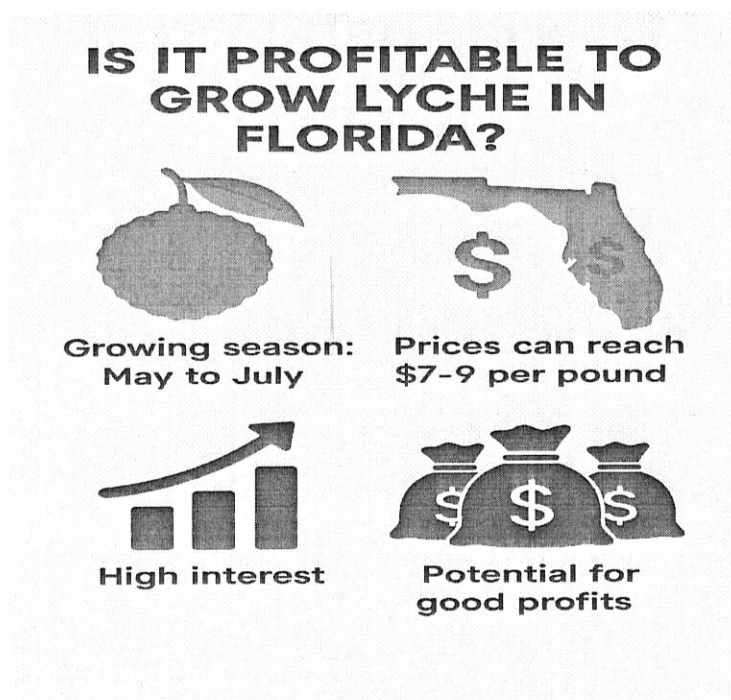

- Avoid frost



HUMIDITY

- Moderate to high humidity preferred



LIGHT

- At least 6-8 hours of direct sunlight per day

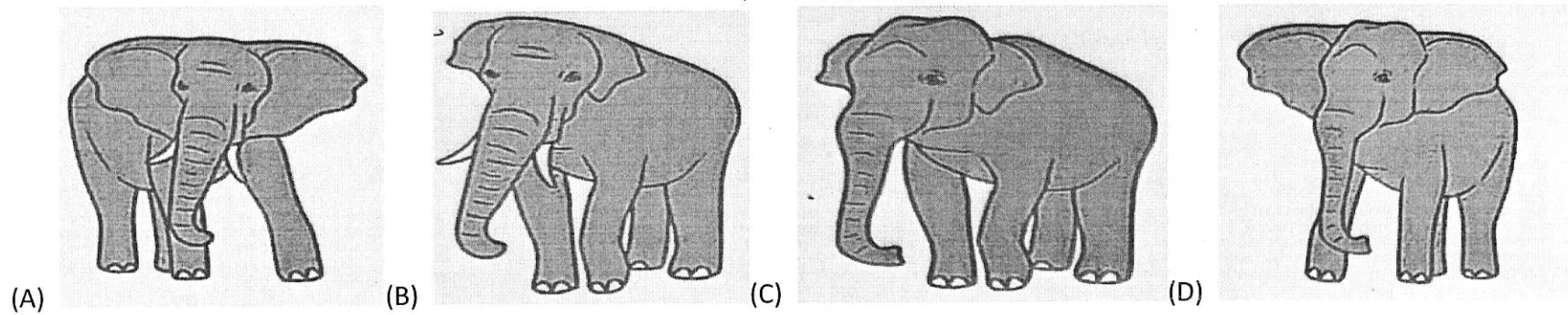
(B) When you go on a safari in Africa, you might have the chance to ride an elephant. But do you know the difference between African and Asian elephants? One easy way to tell them apart is by looking at their ears. African elephants have very large ears, almost as big as their heads, which help them stay cool in the hot African climate. In contrast, Asian elephants live in cooler jungle areas, so they have smaller ears.

Another difference is the shape of their heads. African elephants have round heads, while Asian elephants have twin-domed heads with a dent in the middle. Their size is also different. African elephants are larger, weighing between 4,000 and 7,000 kilograms, while Asian elephants weigh between 3,000 and 5,000 kilograms. In both types, males are heavier than females.

Even though they look different, African and Asian elephants have many things in common. They are both social animals that live in family groups. They also have no natural enemies. However, they are in danger because of illegal hunting for their ivory *tusks and the *destruction of their living areas. As their *population keeps dropping, people need to take action to protect them so that both kinds of elephants don’t end up sharing the same sad future.
