When people want to avoid bad luck, they often say, "Don't jinx it!" __31__ as a noun, the word "jinx" can mean a person or thing that brings misfortune. For instance, someone who __32__ tries to predict the future—like saying, "We're going to lose!"—might be called a jinx. As a verb, "jinx" means causing bad luck by accident, like when you say, "We'll win for sure!" and then lose.

No one knows the exact __33__ of the word, but it became mostly popular in the U.S. in the early 1900s, especially in baseball. People believed that mentioning something good during a game—like a pitcher doing well—could ruin the luck.

Jinxes aren't just for sports! In everyday life, if two people say the same thing __34__, they race to yell "jinx!" first. The slower person (the "jinxee") must stay quiet until someone says their name—or risk bad luck!

Superstitions about jinxes __35__ us that words feel powerful. Whether it's real or not, nobody wants to be the jinx!

Passage 2

Military dependents' villages are an important part of Taiwan's history. Most of these villages were built between the 1940s and 1960s. In 1949, the Kuomintang __36__ to Taiwan after losing the war in China. The government thus built these villages to house soldiers and their families as well as government workers. As cities developed, many of these villages were no longer __37__. However, they are still seen as important cultural symbols. Because of this, actions have been taken to preserve these historical __38__. It's hoped that they will continue to help connect the past with the present.

A famous example is 44 South Village, the first military dependents' village in Taipei. Now, it has been turned into a cultural space that shows what life was like in Taiwan in the mid-1900s. __39__ Taipei 101 in the background, visitors can enjoy both the old and modern sides of the city.

Passage 3

Aspirin and ibuprofen are two common medicines used to relieve pain. Though they are both effective, they function in different ways. Aspirin works by blocking COX enzymes __41__. These enzymes produce something that causes pain, and aspirin makes them unable to work until the body makes new ones. __42__, although ibuprofen also blocks COX enzymes, it only works for a short time. Once its effects __43__, the enzymes can work again. At higher doses, aspirin is more effective for long-lasting pain like arthritis. Meanwhile, ibuprofen is more suitable for short-term pain like muscle aches.

Although both medicines help relieve pain, they can cause side effects. Aspirin can upset your stomach and make you bleed more easily. Ibuprofen is gentler on the stomach but can still cause problems for some people. When choosing between aspirin and ibuprofen, think about your health condition and how the

medicine might __44__ with other drugs you are taking. For example, people who have bleeding problems or are using blood thinners should avoid taking aspirin. And people with kidney problems need to be careful with ibuprofen, as it can lower blood flow and harm the kidneys. Before you use these medicines, be sure to __45__ a doctor to find out which one is best for you.
