



Grit means staying determined and continuing to work hard even when challenges feel tough. In Taiwan, **Morris Chang** is a strong example of grit.

When Chang was young, he did not succeed quickly. He hoped to become a scholar, but failed to enter a doctoral program. This made him feel disappointed and unsure about his future direction. Later, he chose a different path and began working in the technology industry in the United States. He followed strict professional instruction and learned how the technology industry worked. Even after returning to Taiwan in his fifties, he faced doubts about starting a new company. Instead of giving up, Chang explored a clear direction for semiconductor manufacturing and worked in an efficient way. He took full responsibility for his decisions and learned from past failures.

These experiences helped him build a world-leading technology company. His story shows that grit plays an important role in long-term success.
