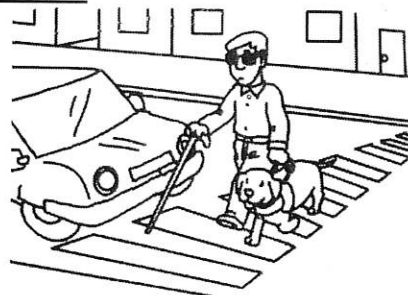

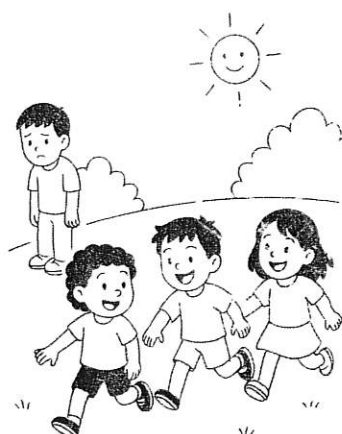

As the first female doctor in the US, Elizabeth Blackwell faced many challenges. Hospitals said no to her, and landlords wouldn't rent her their houses. 26, she kept trying and never gave up. In 1853, she got some small rooms. There, she opened a clinic. She 27 poor women and children who were sick and had no one to help them. After four years, Elizabeth's clinic became the first hospital in the US run completely by women. It was a place for healing and also a training center for women who wanted to study medicine.

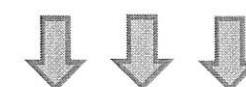
