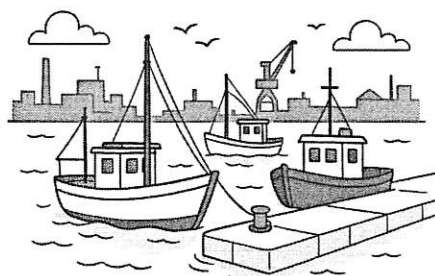

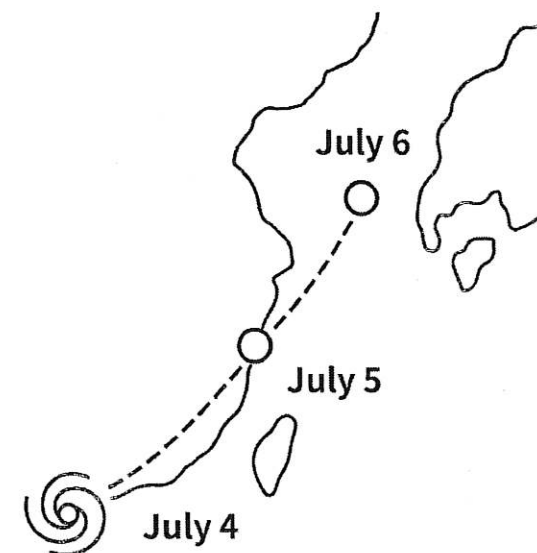

Born in 1821 in the UK, Elizabeth Blackwell grew up in a family that believed in equal rights for men and women. In 1832, her family moved to the US. Young Elizabeth __31__ many interests and didn't think about studying medicine. This changed when she heard a sick friend say, "I wish a woman could be my doctor." Deeply moved by the comment, Elizabeth decided to become one.

However, it was not easy for her to study

medicine. She __32__ by many schools until, in 1847, a medical college in New York finally accepted her. Though she faced unfair treatment, she finished her studies and became the first woman in the US with a medical degree. Passage 2

Animals can help humans protect nature in surprising ways. One good example is the African pouched rat. These clever rats are

trained to help in the fight __36__ illegal wildlife trade. Organizations like APOPO teach them to use their powerful sense of smell to find out hidden wildlife __37__ in shipping ports. Because they can move easily through small spaces, they are perfect for searching boxes or packages that might hold illegal items.

At a busy port in Tanzania, the rats have been used to detect illegal items such as elephant tusks and pangolin scales. They can search boxes quickly and __38__. This is important because X-ray machines are slow, and it's difficult to check every box or package. The rats help workers save time while finding illegal items more efficiently.
