For centuries, elephants have been considered an economically important tool in South Asia. These days, to __31__ them from cruel treatment (殘酷對待), the locals came up with a more humane (人道的) yet still __32__ way—with their dung. 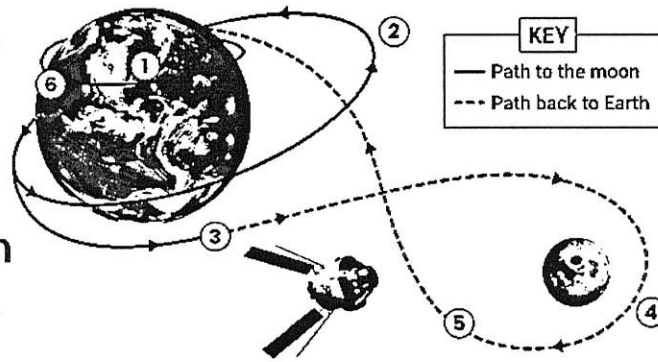

Even during the freezing winter days, many South Koreans will not give up their favorite drink: iced Americano (冰美式). In South Korea, there is even a famous modern expression, "Ah-Ah," which is short for iced Americano. This deep love for cold coffee has created a popular saying in the country: "Eol-Juk-Ah." It means, "Even if I freeze to death, I will drink iced Americano!" Interestingly, South Korean iced Americanos usually have a lower amount of coffee and more water. Because it is a "low-coffee" or light drink, people can enjoy it like water throughout the day without getting too much caffeine. Holding a clear plastic cup filled with ice has become a necessary part of their modern lifestyle.

There are three main reasons for this cold drink culture. First, in Korea's fast-paced society, a freezing drink cools people down instantly and gives them a quick energy boost to fight stress and tiredness. Second, because of the traditional floor-heating system (*Ondol* 暖炕), indoor spaces are very hot and dry in winter, making people crave cold beverages the moment they step inside. Finally, since Korean food is often spicy and greasy, a light, cold coffee is the perfect choice to wash away the heavy oil after lunch.
