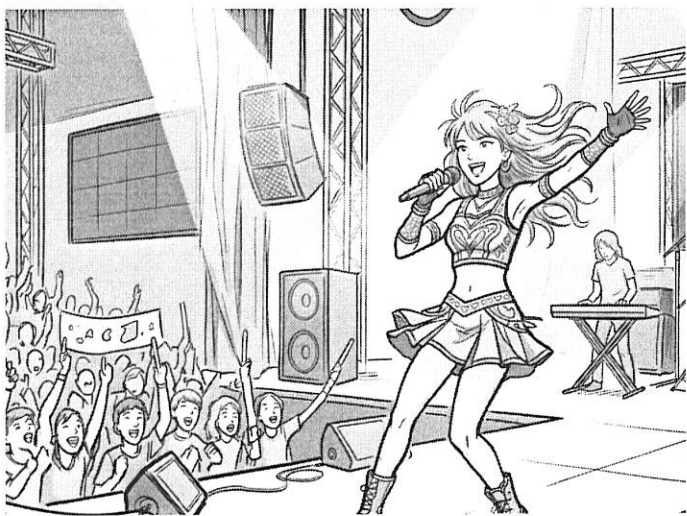

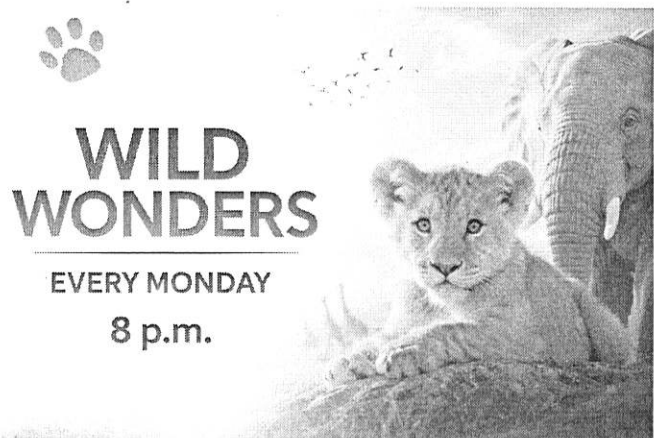

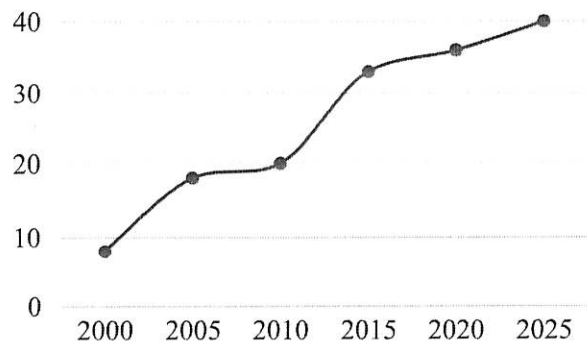

The FIFA World Cup is the biggest football tournament in the world. It takes place every four years and attracts billions of viewers worldwide.

In 1930, the Fédération Internationale de Football Association (FIFA) held the first World Cup in Uruguay. Only 13 teams took part because traveling by sea was slow and expensive. The __36__ was once paused during World War II, so there were no games in 1942 or 1946. When it returned in 1950, Brazil hosted the event. Everyone expected Brazil to win, but Uruguay surprised the world by beating Brazil in the famous final also __37__ the "Maracanazo".
