Passage 2

Gonggi is a fun game from South Korea that has been played for centuries. In the game, players __36__ small stones into the air and quickly catch them with the same hand. It's simple, fun, and often played by kids during school events or festivals while they talk with friends. Thanks to popular Korean movies and TV shows, more people around the world now know about *gonggi*.

Gonggi has been around since __37__ the late 1600s or early 1700s. A painting from that time by Korean artist Yoon Deok-hee shows three boys playing the game. In the past, children used small natural stones to play. Today, people can buy plastic *gonggi* stones for less than ₩700 (about NT\$16). Have you ever turned to coffee or energy drinks when you needed a boost? Both drinks give you energy, but they affect your body in different ways. They taste different, too!

Let's look at their __41__. Coffee comes from roasted coffee beans, and people have been drinking it for hundreds of years. Energy drinks are newer and made in factories. They usually contain caffeine, sugar, and vitamins.
