They used a type of technology called artificial intelligence, or AI for short, to develop ChatGPT. The history of ChatGPT can date back to 2018, when the first version* of the program was released. Since then, the creators have been working hard to make it better and smarter. Today, ChatGPT can understand many languages and can even learn from the conversations it has with people.

People have given ChatGPT a lot of positive comments because it can be helpful in many ways. For example, it can answer questions about many topics, from science and history to cooking and sports. Some people also use ChatGPT to practice speaking a new language. However, there are also some concerns about ChatGPT and other AI technologies.
